1. That the Respondents filed a Motion for Extension of Time to file an Answer to the Notice of Hearing in this matter on 15 April 2005.
2. That Rule 1104 of the Rules and Regulations of the Illinois Securities Law of 1953, 14 Admin Code 130.100 et seq. requires that an answer, special appearance or other responsive pleading to be filed within 30 days of service of the Notice of Hearing upon the Respondent.
3. That the Notice of Hearing was served upon the Respondents' legal counsel by Certified Mail Return Receipt Requested on March 16, 2005. Pursuant to Rule 1104 the Respondent's answer was due on or before April 15, 2005.



4. Rule 1104 does not provide any provision for an extension of time to file an answer. Rule 1104(b) states: Failure, by the respondent to timely file an answer, a special appearance pursuant to Section 130.1107 of this Part, or other responsive pleading shall be deemed an admission of the allegations contained in the Notice of Hearing and waives the respondent's right to a hearing.
5. Rule 1110 sets forth permissible motions. A Motion for Extension of Time [to file an Answer] is not set forth as a permissible motion.

Based upon the above, the Department requests that the Respondents' Motion for Extension of Time be denied.
